Prairie County Board of Commissioners Christine Keltner and Dennis Teske met in regular session at 9:00 a.m. In attendance Administrative Assistant Harry McNall. Commissioner Todd Devlin is in Helena.

9:00 a.m. Pledge of Allegiance, Public Comment. Brooke Metrione with Tim Sheehy's office stopped into meet the commissioners. Sheila Dixon and Shane Eaton joined the meeting.

9:00 a.m. Announcement: the 2:00 p.m. agenda item to 11:00 a.m. today.

9:05 a.m. Road Supervisor Todd Henry joined the meeting.

9:08 a.m. Shane Eaton spoke with Brooke Metrione about wind development in Eastern Montana. Commissioner Teske gave information about wind development and social security, and other related issues with wind development.

Sheila Dixon, spoke briefly about bonding issues with wind projects. Shane Eaton made a comment about FWP doing bird surveys, are they looking at taking sharp tail grouse out of the county? Please look into this with FWP. He also made a comment about the government selling public land in Nevada. He is asking the commissioners to write a letter in support of selling public lands within Prairie County. Shane Commented on the March 8th Terry Tribune Article, would like the land planning board or commissioners to clarify with the newspaper the purpose of the scoping letter, and another comment that was made within the article should be removed about who returned the survey. Shane ask about "draft" scoping letters, and how those were received. Shane wants an investigation into those draft scoping letters.
