

Prairie County Board of Commissioners Meeting

November 15, 2021

Prairie County Commissioners Todd Devlin, Christine Keltner and Deanna Bockness met in regular session at 9 a.m. In attendance were Road Supervisor Todd Henry and Road Specialist Gary Pfiefler. Pledge of Allegiance recited.

November 3, 2021, road minutes reviewed. Regan Plumbing and Heating replaced the boiler safety valve at the County Road Shop and MACO insurance has been notified. The 772-road grader has yet to be serviced by a mechanic.

Road Specialist Pfiefler reported being in contact with the Bureau of Land Management and working on the required paperwork for the Cabin Creek, Singleton Exploration, Little Sheep Mountain, Cherry Creek and Chapman gravel pits.

Commissioners reviewed the cattleguard policy with no changes made at this time.

Road Supervisor Henry reported that crew is blading roads and hauling gravel on Flat Top Road.
