Jeff Key is the main project manager, and he is dedicated to finishing this project to completion.

The current state of the project is an internal review for the final fix of the bridge. It is projected to start construction in July of 2025, with an estimated finish date of October 2025. The meeting today will go over the project plans, and a physical visit to the bridge and a similar bridge called Kinsey Bridge in Custer County.

Jeff Keys went over in detail the printed plans, what might be new to the bridge and other important key notes of the project plans. These are not final plans and will continue to be

adjusted as it goes. The county commissioners have till July 9th to submit any comments or concerns over the plans for construction.

10:30 a.m. Commissioners went to Milwaukee bridge to continue the meeting. A good discussion happened at the bridge about options for heavy equipment transportation and other items. Pat Haughain attended the meeting and agreed to sign a paper with the county to allow access through his property during construction of the final project for construction purposes. Commissioners will create an agreement, and get it signed by all parties.
