

## **Prairie County Board of Commissioners Meeting**

June 12<sup>th</sup>, 2024

In attendance were Chair Todd Devlin, Commissioner Christine Keltner and Commissioner Dennis Teske.

9:00 a.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Public Comment, there was none.

9:30 a.m. Road Department – Todd Henry. Discussion was held on the Cherry Creek Gravel Pit. The BLM will meet with the Commissioners at the gravel pit during at 3:30 p.m. Public Comment Period. The Commissioner will read over the DEQ permit prior to the BLM meeting.

10:00 a.m. The Commissioners monthly zoom was held with updates on the progress of the Milwaukee Bridge. The Zoom meeting representatives in attendance were the Commissioners, EPEDC, MTDOT, Great West Engineering and Western Federal Highway Administration.

10:45 a.m. EPEDC stayed after the Zoom meeting and offered updates on Southeastern Montana. They asked questions of what issues Prairie County has or is currently dealing with.

11:30 a.m. Minutes from the May 29, 2024, meeting were read. Commissioner Teske made the motion to approve the minutes as amended and corrected. Commissioner Keltner 2nd the motion, no further discussion. All in favor, motion passed.

Correspondence: MtNRC dues 24/25. Commissioner Teske made a motion to pay the dues of \$1962.00 from 1000. 330. Commissioner Keltner 2nd the motion. Discussion held on events of MtNRC. No further discussion, all in favor motion passed.

Correspondence: Two letters from MT Opioid. 1st letter was public hearing notice. The 2nd letter was on payment notice.

12:00 Noon: Lunch

1:00 p.m. Doug Hjorth, Sheila and Nick Dixon were in to discuss a water leak in the alley of the 300 block of Fallon. The alley is between Cato and Currie. It appears an artesian well is free flowing from a broken water line. The discussion of ownership of the well/ water source and who pays was held. We are not sure of the water source ownership, but the leak needs repaired. It is agreed when we find who owns the well, they will reimburse the County for the cost of the repair to the pipeline.

The cost estimate to repair the pipeline is \$1000.00. Commissioner Teske made a motion to pay the estimate of repair and continue to search for the responsible party. Commissioner Devlin 2nd the motion, no more discussion, motion passed.

1:40 P.M. Treasure Morrison brought in Tax Abatements that were figured wrong. Commissioner Teske made a motion to sign the Tax Abatements.

Commissioner Keltner 2nd the motion, no further discussion. All in favor motion passed.

1:50 p.m. County Attorney Dan Rice informed the Commissioners the contract for the Milwaukee Bridge repair was a standard contract and no changes were required. Commissioner Teske made a motion to sign the contract, 2nd by Commissioner Keltner. No more discussion all in favor motion passed.

2:00 p.m. Mosquitoes spraying- Discussion about the Districts requirements to spray because it is a voted-on mill level by the voters of Terry.
