

RESOLUTION NO. 25-10

A RESOLUTION PURSUANT TO §7-6-4006 OF THE MONTANA CODE ANNOTATED, AUTHORIZING AMENDMENT OF FINAL BUDGET FOR FY 2024-2025 IN THE GENERAL FUND TO ACCOUNT FOR UNANTICIPATED LOAN REVENUE FOR THE PURCHASE OF A SHERIFF'S VEHICLE.

WHEREAS, Prairie County wishes to amend the budget for Fiscal Year 2024-2025 to provide for an increase in appropriations authority in the general fund, as the result of unanticipated loan revenue used to purchase a new sheriff's vehicle;

AND WHEREAS, such amendment of the final budget will result in an overall increase in appropriation authority within the funds identified herein,

AND WHEREAS, the provisions of §7-6-4006 MCA require public hearing upon any budget amendment resulting in an overall increase in appropriation authority,


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Prairie County Board of Commissioners as follows:

1. The appropriations for the Final Budget for Fiscal Year 2024-2025 shall be increased in the following amounts:

- \$50,000 in Fund 4010 as the result of unanticipated loan proceeds for purchase of a new sheriff's vehicle and equipment,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a public hearing shall be held on the above proposed amendment to the Final Budget for Fiscal Year 2024-2025 on the 16th day of October, 2024, at 1:30 pm in the Prairie County Court House. The Clerk & Recorder shall cause notice of such hearing to be published in the Terry Tribune, in accordance with §7-1-2121 MCA, at least 2 times with at least 6 days separating each publication.


